<p>HM – The Broads Authority have completed a carbon audit, but they will struggle currently to hit their NetZero target. Further mitigations actions will be needed.</p>	

<p>GP – Breckland will be publishing its latest carbon footprint soon, it is significantly impacted by COVID so it is unlikely it will so a realistic position until 2022-23. A narrative will be put in place to explain why this is the case.</p> <p>PB – Great Yarmouth’s carbon reduction plan has been approved, with a sustainability strategy aiming to reach net zero by 2035.</p> <p>PH - Norwich is developing a biodiversity strategy.</p>
